 mandated. It is recommended that no officer serve more than three consecutive years in
 the same office.

LEADERSHIP NOMINATIONS PROCESS STEPS (approved by Church Council)

- Current Church leaders who have served 2 or more 3-year terms and are coming off a
 3-year term will be nominated for just 1 year. (This will help us attrite them more quickly.)
- Every current church leader who has served for 10 years or more must sit out for a minimum of 3 years. They will be identified and tagged as mentors for 1840 Young Adults.
- To attrite those who have served 10 years or more, go to the Book of Discipline recommended minimum membership of 5, if needed.
- Each Administrative Committee will now have two co-chairs—one of which must be a young adult—except for the Board of Trustees, Treasurer, Lay Member of Annual Conference, and Staff-Pastor-Parish Relations Committee (SPPRC). ¶ 247.4) 8. Pg.179
